What Is AtHoc PA?

During normal operations and after a disruptive event, AtHoc PA is the process of:

- Assessing individuals' status and location
- Confirming personnel safety and identifying those exposed to heightened risk
- Enabling continued operations before, during and after the event

This critical data equips decision-makers with personnel visibility and situational awareness – key factors in operational readiness.

With AtHoc PA, leadership makes informed, safety-critical decisions about resource deployment, speedy assistance to personnel in need and rapid incident resolution.

AtHoc PA can be initiated at a variety of organizational levels: base, installation, facility, regional or enterprise-wide.

Alerts are activated via multiple IP and non-IP modalities. More specifically, targeted personnel respond to alerts with status reports generated from virtually any device: mobile phone (via call, text or app), desktop or laptop computer, IP phone, text or email.



AtHoc Pa Provides Comprehensive Protection In Three Key Arenas:

1 Readiness PA

Ensures that geographically dispersed personnel are continuously accounted for and available to perform assigned duties. This vital readiness information enhances operations continuity.

2 On-Scene Operational PA

Lets field personnel communicate directly with HQ. As they perform daily operations, their location and status are always known.

3 Post-Event PA

In crises, alerts individuals and sends a request for the status of personnel in the incident vicinity. Leadership can rapidly assess impact on operational readiness, then deploy assets to manage the incident and provide assistance to individuals in need.

- Increases personnel confidence and trust in leadership across the organization
- Provides rapidly available and accurate personnel status
- Decreases reaction time after incident onset
- Reduces duration required to return operations to a normal state
- Decreases recovery costs

- A federal agency accounts for and assesses the status of affected personnel following a critical incident
- A geographically dispersed military command ensures accurate status reporting for 1,200 personnel
- An HMO uses mobile phones to track the safety and operational status of remote home healthcare workers
- In emergencies, a university accounts for faculty and staff, letting security provide direction and follow-up
- Organizations track personnel entering and exiting sensitive zones or hazardous facilities
